

# LECTOR

## Sunday Celebration in the absence of a priest or deacon (SCAP)

### Plymouth Schedule

The first and second readings, Gospel and the Prayer of the Faithful will be proclaimed by the regularly scheduled lector using only **AT HOME WITH THE WORD**. The Book of the Gospels is not used.

The opening prayer and other prayers will be led by a designated Eucharistic minister, wearing a wireless microphone (if necessary) and taking a position in the sanctuary. The presidential chair is not used. Communion will be distributed in one species (host).

The lector places **AT HOME WITH THE WORD** on the ambo and advises the assembly of the absence of the priest using words similar to:

**Fr. \_\_\_\_\_ is unable to celebrate Mass with us (provide the reason for the priest's absence). In his absence we will have a Service of the Word with Communion. This service is not a mass, but under the current circumstances, it satisfies our Sunday obligation.**

**The collection will be taken up at the conclusion of our service.**

The lector then advises the assembly of alternate Masses from the following list:

**Those who may wish to attend Mass, rather than participate in this service,**

**(4:00 PM)** may do so here, tomorrow morning at 7:30 or 11:30.

**(7:30 AM)** may do so here at 11:30 this morning.

**(11:30AM)** will find, unfortunately, there are no local Masses later today.

The lector then reads the announcements in the normal way and takes a seat in the assembly.

## **LITURGY OF THE WORD**

The readings, including the Gospel, are proclaimed by the lector in the normal way from **At Home With The Word** (included in the lector SCAP packet). The lectionary is not used. If there are two lectors scheduled, the first lector will proclaim the first two readings and the gospel; the second lector will read the reflection and the intercessions. The psalm and the acclamation before the gospel will be led by the leader of song in the normal way.

### **First Reading**

Psalm

### **Second Reading**

Acclamation

### **Gospel**

Following the gospel, the lector says:

**Please be seated for a reflection on today's readings...**

The lector will read the **Scripture Insights** for the specific Sunday found in **At Home With The Word**, included in the lector packet; **(do not read the questions at the end of the Scripture Insights)** and then return to the assembly. If the Leader has returned to the assembly for the readings, he/she now moves back to the sanctuary.

## **Profession of Faith**

All recite the creed in the normal way. The lector returns to the ambo at the end of the creed.

## **General Intercessions**

**Leader:**

**With faith in God's promises, let us now present our needs and petitions.**

The lector then leads the Prayer of the Faithful in the normal way and returns to the assembly after the leader concludes the prayer. The service then continues with Communion. There is no recessional.
